



**14/008 To consider a request for a memorial seat on the Recreation Ground**

SW advised that the family of the late Connie Chrystal who recently passed away would like to place a seat on the meadow in her memory. This was agreed in principle but a suitable location will need to be agreed.

**14/009 To discuss any Urgent matters of interest to the parish**

- CG reported that the local branch of the British Legion has advised that any event to mark the commemoration of WW1 should be arranged by the Parish Council. CG has been in touch with Rev. Hilary Davey and a service will be held in Debden Church on Sunday evening, 3<sup>rd</sup> August, further details will be given when available.
- CG reported that a resident is organising a 35 mile cycle ride to raise money for the Carver Barracks Injured Soldiers Fund and has requested permission to use the car park on Saturday, 30<sup>th</sup> August as a meeting point and for riders to leave their cars. This was approved by the Council providing vehicles are not parked on the grass verge.
- CG has received an email regarding the nuisance caused by motor bikes and four wheel drives at Hamperden End. This will be raised with Cty Cllr S. Walsh.
- One allotment tenant is not complying with the Allotment Agreement and a further letter will be sent.
- The UDC Local Plan Pre-submission consultation closes on 2<sup>nd</sup> June. HO'B will draft a response and circulate to all members.
- CG advised that the Annual Governance Statement and Accounts will need to be signed before the deadline of 6<sup>th</sup> June. It was agreed to hold an additional meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> May.
- A request was made for meetings to be held monthly. This will be included on the next agenda.
